Call for Case Presentations

Texas Transplantation Society is pleased to invite the submission of Case Presentations of a clinical nature commencing February 8, 2012.

Submission Guidelines

- Any Texas Transplantation Society (TTS) associate member or resident/fellow may submit a case presentation. The 2012 Program subcommittee will review for suitability and group according to topic.
- Individuals not yet belonging to the Texas Transplantation Society must also complete a membership application and submit it with the first year's dues at the time of submission.
- The case presentation must be submitted with your completed application form (see attached).
- Those who submit case reports that are accepted by the committee must register for the meeting at the appropriate member rate. TTS does not offer travel or hotel reimbursements for case presenters, except for the winner. All travel arrangements and hotel reservations are the responsibility of the individual, not TTS.
- Case presentations should be no longer than 10 minutes and should include no more than 10 slides. An additional 5 minutes will be allowed for questions and answers.
- At the conclusion of the case presentations, attendees and faculty will be asked to vote on the best presentation; the winner will be announced at the July 2012 meeting.
- Deadline for submission is Monday, May 7, 2012 via email.
- Entries must be sent electronically by emailing as a PDF or word document to: SLargent@transplanttexas.org.
- All case presentations accepted by the committee should plan on presenting orally at the July meeting.
- Winner will be reimbursed for their travel and hotel as follows: up to \$200 for round-trip travel (either air fare or mileage based on prevailing IRS rates); and one nights' stay at the host hotel at no charge (room and tax only).

All case presentations will be reviewed by the 2012 Program subcommittee; the committee has the right to make the final decision on which case presentations will be accepted; all case presentations accepted by the committee will be published in the meeting syllabus, which will be distributed on-site, as well as on the TTS website, author permitting.

Presenting authors of accepted case presentations are required to register for the TTS annual meeting before June 26, 2012. All travel arrangements and hotel reservations are the responsibility of the individual, not TTS.
